



2019 Raft-Up Reminders – Let's Party the Gilligan's Island Way!

Ice: While we will have extra ice chests full of ice, we are politely asking that all boats, boat captains and anyone needing ice for the weekend - please get your ice **either BEFORE noon on Friday or AFTER 6pm on Saturday**. Or, you can come get a bag of ice earlier in the week and take it home to your freezer.

After noon on Friday, we will need all ice to keep food cold for the dinner but we will be fine once the dinner is over. This will ensure that everyone has what they need.

Fridge: The refrigerator must be entirely cleaned out by 3pm, Friday, May 24th. We will be bringing in food for Saturday night's dinner. *If you are bringing anything with you for the dinner on Saturday, please be prepared to bring your own cooler as there will be NO SPACE!*

T-Docks: Please be respectful of the T-Dock sign-up lists. Space is at a premium and the Fleet Captain and his designees will be enforcing the sign-up list. Any boat attempting to use a space they did not sign up for will be asked to move. If you need space, please be prepared to either be rafted up to another boat (space and participation willing – at the discretion of the Fleet Captain and his designees) or take a berth in the Municipal Marina.

Parking and Boat Ramp Access

We are expecting a lot of members and guests to be at the club this holiday weekend for the Raft-Up Dinner, the Sunday Raft-Up and because it's a three-day weekend! Please be respectful when parking and DO NOT, under any circumstance, block access to the boat ramp or block in the boats on trailers!

Dinner reservations will close Monday, May 20th. You must choose your entrée (salmon or chicken) and pay online. Boat registrations close on Monday, May 20th. Please contact Tony Angel (727) 459-7900 or Joel Heyne (727-345-5760) with boat registration inquiries.

No payments or registrations will be accepted at the door.
